Summary of activities

Transition Village Wallan proposes to build 7 Tiny Houses to provide safe, stable, short to medium term accommodation for people local tour area, who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. Residents will be offered a 12 month tenancy in the Village. During that time, with the assistance of a Transition Worker, each resident will develop a Personal Program of health and welfare support, skills and education training and re connection with community which will assist them to regain self confidence and skills to ensure successful living. The Village has embedded sustainable living and design skills into the Village philosophy enable residents to develop resilience in the face of future uncertainties. A two way relationship will be developed between the village residents and the local community. Residents will have the opportunity for friendship and mentoring with community members. They will be actively encouraged to join community organization for sports, volunteering or social events. TVW is a housing first model of support for local people who are homeless.
